## BURSARY AWARD CONDITIONS

We are on a mission to ensure STEM is accessible and inclusive for all. Financial support is provided to organisations who would not otherwise be able to participate in the programme. In addition to the standard conditions of entry recipients agree to:

- Accept the bursary (and the associated conditions herein) within 14 days of being notified
- Make any commitment fee due within 30 days of receiving an invoice
- Participate fully in the programme including attendance at a regional tournament (no entry fee)
- Comply with any reasonable requests related to sponsor recognition


## Participation

Bursaries are a valuable commodity intended to promote inclusion. The kits are reusable year on year. To ensure kits are fully utilised recipients are expected to fully engage and commit to participating in the programme over multiple years. All kits provided via our bursary programme remain the property of FIRST UK for 3 years from the date of this award or until 31 July 2023 whichever is the later.

## Treatment of VAT

VAT is fully recoverable by schools and education establishments. In accordance with our charitable status and HMRC guidance all bursary recipients will be issued with invoices as follows:
